Architectures of Cultural Revitalisation

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Food Sovereignty and local well-being

- Subsistence activities effected with locally crafted tools bring a high degree of autonomy to provisioning communities;
- In the latter half of the 20th century there has been an increasing tendency to rely on industrially produced inputs to facilitate life on the land;
- The living memory of previous autonomous technologies is an important chapter in building food sovereignty.

Stories of cooperation regarding cultural revitalisation

- Many museums have filed away examples of material technologies;
- Variouslly called “repatriation” or “sharing”, dialogues with host communities allow the re-engineering of these artefacts.
- The conservations often involve designing new digital tools to access artefacts.



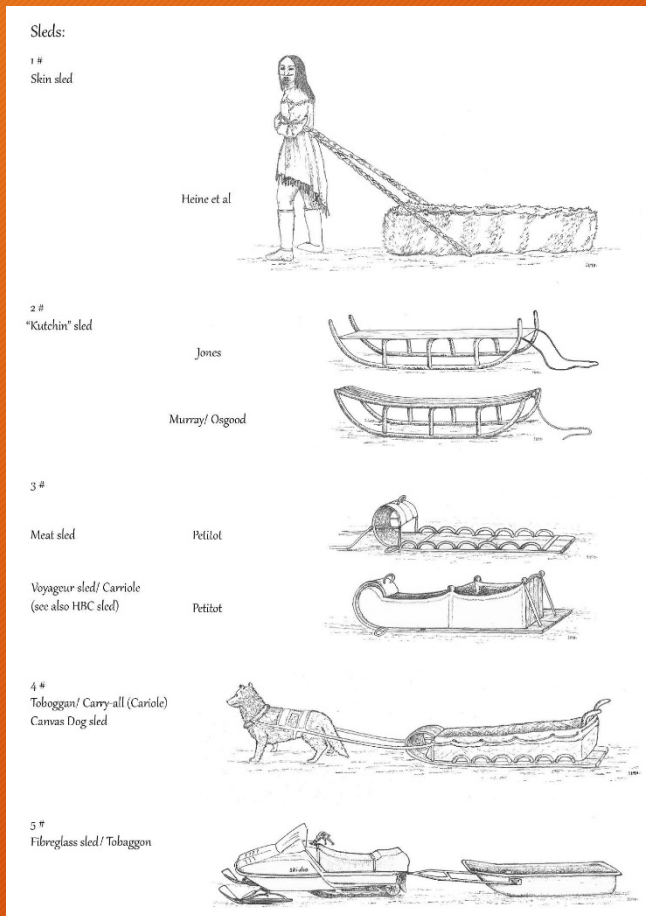
